Weekly Theme: Martin Luther King, Jr.; snow; winter; 100

This Week:

Reading: I will be going over books with each group at guided reading. These books should be on your child's level so they should be able to read them to you independently. They may need a reminder to sound out the words. Please make sure they read & retell them to you. They should also have a library book. If they have time they may read it too. Please remember to sign your child's reading log in their red homework folder. They should be reading around 10 to 15 minutes a night. If your child forgets their book you can have them practice their word list. Your child will be working in class on phonics, spelling, and writing work stations. We are focusing beginning consonant blends, ending consonant blends, & reading word list B during the 2nd trimester.

Math: We will be continue and test over our first topic over subtraction this week. We will begin our 2nd topic over subtraction next week.

Phonics/Spelling: Phonics & spelling are done in class. This week we are working on new heart words: him, into, put, has, & look. We will also work on one & multiple syllable words as well as open syllable words.

Grammar/Writing: We will be writing in our journals. We will complete some directive drawings & write about them.
