Weekly Theme: review of Kindergarten; spiders; bats

## This Week:

<u>Reading</u>: I will be going over books with each group at guided reading. These books should be on your child's level so they should be able to read them to you independently. They may need a reminder to sound out the words. Please make sure they read & retell them to you. They should also have a library book. If they have time they may read it too. Please remember to sign your child's reading log in their red homework folder. They should be reading around 10 to 15 minutes a night. If your child forgets their book you can have them practice their word list. Your child will be working in class on phonics, spelling, and writing work stations. We are focusing on CVC (consonant/ vowel/ consonant), beginning consonant blends, beginning consonant digraphs, reading word list A, as well as a review of kindergarten skills during the 1<sup>st</sup> trimester.

<u>Math</u>: We will be working on place value for the next 2 - 3 weeks.

<u>Phonics/Spelling</u>: Phonics & spelling are done in class. This week we are working on new heart words: one, had, by, but, & not. We will also work on digraphs ch and wh & review digraphs sh & th.

Grammar/Writing: We will be writing in our journals. We will also complete a writing about spiders and begin learning about bats.
