Weekly Theme: Thanksgiving

This Week:

Reading: I will be going over books with each group at guided reading. These books should be on your child's level so they should be able to read them to you independently. They may need a reminder to sound out the words. Please make sure they read & retell them to you. They should also have a library book. If they have time they may read it too. Please remember to sign your child's reading log in their red homework folder. They should be reading around 10 to 15 minutes a night. If your child forgets their book you can have them practice their word list. Your child will be working in class on phonics, spelling, and writing work stations. We are focusing beginning consonant blends, ending consonant blends, & reading word list B during the 2nd trimester.

Math: We will continue & test over our 2nd topic on place value.

Phonics/Spelling: Phonics & spelling are done in class. This week we are working on new heart words: your, can, said, there, & down. We will also work on trigraphs tch & dge. For now I will not send any spelling words home for your child to work on.

Grammar/Writing: We will be writing in our journals. We may complete a writing about our favorite zoo animal. We will also complete a writing about pumpkins. We will also complete a list of our favorite Thanksgiving foods.
