Weekly Theme:   spring

This Week:



Reading: I will be going over books with each group at guided reading. These books should be on your child's level so they should be able to read them to you independently. They may need a reminder to sound out the words. Please make sure they read & retell them to you. They should also have a library book. If they have time they may read it too. Please remember to sign your child's reading log in their red homework folder. They should be reading around 10 to 15 minutes a night. If your child forgets their book you can have them practice their word list. Your child will be working in class on phonics, spelling, and writing work stations. We are focusing on long vowel sounds, multi syllable words, & reading word list B during the 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester.



Math: We will work on a unit over money. We will start Rocket Math. Rocket Math is a timed addition sheet your child will complete daily to try to improve their addition fact skills.



Phonics/Spelling: Phonics & spelling are done in class. This week we are working on new heart words: good, around, know, too, & every. We will also work on one & multiple syllable words with the vowel consonant e pattern.



Grammar/Writing: We will complete a writing about our spring break. We will also share what we did with the class.



Social Studies/Science: We will read and discuss our Scholastic News or Science Spin lesson. We will also be listening to read alouds from Redbud books & spring.
