Weekly Theme:   spring

This Week:



Reading: I will be going over books with each group at guided reading. These books should be on your child's level so they should be able to read them to you independently. They may need a reminder to sound out the words. Please make sure they read & retell them to you. They should also have a library book. If they have time they may read it too. Please remember to sign your child's reading log in their red homework folder. They should be reading around 10 to 15 minutes a night. If your child forgets their book you can have them practice their word list. Your child will be working in class on phonics, spelling, and writing work stations. We are focusing on long vowel sounds, multi syllable words, & reading word list B during the 3<sup>rd</sup> trimester.



Math: We will complete & test over money. We will continue Rocket Math.



Phonics/Spelling: Phonics & spelling are done in class. This week we are working on new heart words: pretty, away, after, think, & going. We will also work on the other vowel sound of oo & vowel team patterns.



Grammar/Writing: We will complete a directed drawing and writing that goes along with our weekly Rooted in Reading book. We will also complete journal writings.



Social Studies/Science: We will read and discuss our Scholastic News or Science Spin lesson. We will also be listening to read alouds from Redbud books & spring.
