Weekly Theme: back to school; review of Kindergarten

This Week:

Reading: I will be testing the next 2 weeks so your child will have a guided reading book but I won't be going over the book much with them. Please make sure they read & retell them to you. They should also have a library book. If they have time they may read it too. Please remember to sign your child's reading log in their red homework folder. They should be reading around 10 to 15 minutes a night. If your child forgets their book you can have them practice their word list. Your child will be working in class on phonics, spelling, and writing work stations. We are focusing on CVC (consonant/vowel/consonant), beginning consonant blends, beginning consonant digraphs, reading word list A, as well as a review of kindergarten skills during the 1st trimester.

Math: We are starting our first 1st grade math topic today. It is addition. We will be working on adding to 12 with manipulatives.

<u>Phonics/Spelling</u>: Phonics & spelling are done in class. This week we are working on closed syllable real & nonsense words. Spelling is done in the classroom each Friday as part of our phonics lessons. We cover the patterns we are working on in phonics. Your child will <u>not</u> have a list of words to practice at home.

Grammar/Writing: We will be writing in our journals. We will also write about our friends and family. We are focusing on writing complete sentences.
